Welcome all to the 17th year of Plano Tamil School, a 100% volunteer run organization, a subsidiary of Sastha Tamil Foundation - www.stfnonprofit.org, a registered 501(c)3 non-profit organization with over 60+ volunteers as teachers, facilitators and administrators.



Year in Review – A Recap

We started 2017 – 2018 academic years with a record enrollment of 330 students. This is our 17th year of service towards providing quality Tamil language education. This is our first year of concurrent enrollment at Frisco ISD, through which children who are enrolled in Frisco ISD and pursuing Level 7 and Level 8 at our school get 2 world language credits, considered towards their graduation plan from ISD. Our first set of children will be graduating with LoTE credit next and we are so excited about this. We thank our Teachers, Volunteers, Parents, Students and all the patrons for the unstinted support.

Venue

Plano Tamil school continues to run its operations from 2 buildings - one in Hedgcoxe Road and the other in Rasor Blvd.

Curriculum

There was no change to the curriculum plans and Plano Tamil School continues to follow a blended curriculum that combines the best of ATA (American Tamil Academy, www.amtaac.org) one of the versatile Tamil language boards in North America and our in-house curriculum which has been refined and adjusted based on students, teachers and parents feedback.

The school is continuing to provide report cards to all the students at the end of each unit. Students' Attendance, Homework and their Unit Test grades are taken into account in

generating the report cards for each unit. Report cards were generated by using a data management tool Fedena.

- Students may only request credit for the courses listed above after completion of the 6th grade year in Frisco ISD.
- Students will need to provide the transcript to be reviewed verifying completion of the language course no earlier than the Spring of the student's 8th grade year. The transcript must include the language and level(s) completed.
- The only credits accepted are for the two courses listed above.
- GPA points will not be awarded for concurrent enrollment courses.

Teacher's Training & Staff Development:

The kickoff for the current school year was initiated with a Teacher Orientation Program at the Velus residence. Volunteers are a critical part of the tamil school. The Mission, Vision and the higher purpose of why we are doing what we are doing was discussed in detail. An overview of the organizational approach was also provided. The calendar for the school year was circulated. Orientation logistics were discussed. The highlight of the teacher orientation was the in-depth interactive Q&A that helped all the volunteers learn about the Plano Tamil School culture. Teacher's guidelines and the Room Volunteer guidelines was also circulated among the volunteers. This was followed by a delicious lunch which everyone enjoyed . Everyone felt that the events of the day set the tone for an exciting school year and appreciated and thanked the school for conducting it.



During the school year, the school also arranged for another teacher training with Dr.Sankaran Radhakrishnan, Lecturer - Dept. of South Asian Studies, UT Austin. It was an all day event. After the training, all the teachers and volunteers felt that the training provided them with lot of value add in terms of delivering the teaching to the students. The key



highlight of the training was that tamil should be taught to the students here in the u.s. as a second language and not as a first language.

The Vaaram Oru Thuli (வாரம் ஒரு துளி) is distributed to the Plano Tamil School Google group members throughout the year, every Friday.



Communication

School updates are sent out to each student's family every week. Our communication includes school news, a calendar of events and other useful information. Vaaram Oru Thuli, containing interesting facts, is also sent every week. Parents may keep a close eye on the communication to be fully informed of PTS' happenings. School annual report will be sent out annually. You may also receive emails about class progress and any other general information from your respective teachers.

Reading Program and Library Activities

Tamil Library: The Plano Tamil School Library is one of the attractions for the students and their parents. In the academic year 2017-2018, few changes were introduced in order to accommodate the student growth and demand since 2010.

At the beginning of the year, the Library was operated only in Hedgcoxe AMH location. Since the new location was opened, the Students from Level 3 – Level 7 moved to the new location Rasor AMH. It was inconvenient for the students to come and check out books from one Library location. So we have introduced a new branch in the new location for the benefit of the students.

More than 50 **new books were added** as part of this academic year due to the student growth.

This academic year, we had a substantial growth in registration with over **240 registered library members**.

Initially we started this Tamil Library with only 40 books, now we have around **1500+ books**. This collection includes Children's story books, Bilingual books, Novels etc. Our children's books collection has many different varieties. We have books that are suitable for children of all ages, especially the younger children who are just starting to read. We also maintain around 250+ storybooks and magazines for the adults.

Reading Log Program

As part of this reading log program, Library books were given to each class based on the level. These books were distributed and exchanged every week to the students with the help of Room Volunteers or Teachers.

Around **350 level-wise books** were distributed for this Reading log program.

During every 6th week presentation, one student from each class was selected for the reading log winner and awarded during the presentation. This year we have given pencils, highlighters, bookmarks as a gift to those winners. Around **56 winners** are recognized in this academic year.

Also during the Annual day celebration, from each Level, one **grand prize winner was recognized** for the whole academic year.
