Welcome all to the 19th year of Plano Tamil School, a 100% volunteer run organization, a subsidiary of Sastha Tamil Foundation - <a href="www.stfnonprofit.org">www.stfnonprofit.org</a>, a registered 501(c)3 non-profit organization with over 60+ volunteers as teachers, facilitators and administrators.





### **Year in Review – A Recap**

We started 2019 – 2020 academic years with a record enrollment of 370 students. This is our 19th year of service towards providing quality Tamil language education. This is our third year of concurrent enrollment at Frisco ISD, through which children who are enrolled in Frisco ISD and pursuing Level 7 and Level 8 at our school get 2 world language credits, considered towards their graduation plan from ISD & our second set of children are graduating with LoTE credit. We thank our Teachers, Volunteers, Parents, Students and all the patrons for the unstinted support.

#### Venue

In an effort to accomodate the continuous growth of our Tamil school population and to

conduct all levels in one location, we have moved into a newer and larger venue. Our school is now located at **Genstar Montessori**, 10205, Custer Road, Plano, TX.

1:30 PM to 3:30 PM - Level 6, Level 7 & level 8

3:45 PM to 5:45 PM - Level 1 thru Level 5

#### **Student Volunteers**

Plano Tamil School is so proud to announce that there are 17 student volunteers. These are students who have studied/graduated from Plano Tamil School and are returning to our school to volunteer their time and "give back" to the community.



#### Curriculum

There was no change to the curriculum plans and Plano Tamil School continues to follow a

blended curriculum that combines the best of ATA (American Tamil Academy, www.amtaac.org) one of the versatile Tamil language boards in North America and our in-house curriculum which has been refined and adjusted based on students, teachers and parents feedback. Using a streamlined, cohesive way of introducing Tamil, each level was appropriately divided so that we still preserve the comprehensive essence of the language. These are a few salient features of our curriculum. The students were provided with ATA books and our in-house books to support their academic progression. The curriculum continues to inspire the students by providing a best in class learning experience. A few items like storytelling, 6<sup>th</sup> week presentation, reading log program, and Thirukkural learning continue to distinguish our students while promoting the all-round development of a student's personality.

The school continued to provide report cards for each unit in the academic year. Student's Attendance, Homework and their Unit test grades were taken into account in generating the report cards for each unit.

#### **E** - Learning

In an effort of enhancing the technology usage, the school continued the **GSuite** platform for communicating with the students and parents.

Continuation of online homework using the tools like **Quizlet, Tamil keyboard typing** made the students more enthusiastic to learn the language. This year, the school invested n purchasing 6 tablets, apart from a chromebook which was already in use to provide for the students of all levels to make use of this e-learning more effectively in the classroom settings. We also tried another online learning tool called Book Widgets in one of our levels as a pilot program.

#### **E-Learning approach**:

An e-learning page was designed detailing the e-learning approach that the school planned to take.

- We bought 6 Samsung tablets with rugged cases Aug / Sep 2019.
- We configured the tablets to be locked down to enterprise level security for safety of kids (Disabling browser, camera, secure password etc.)
- We curated APPS that are appropriate per level Kids were grouped into 6 teams and they take turns to use the 6 Tablets. Every class will get 1-2 times in 6 weeks.
- Students were then taught to use and learn the APPS that gamify TAMIL learning

- according to their level / age.
- In addition to the in class time, the same apps were provided as free links for kids to practice at home using their own device. (Instructions provided on the eLearning Portal)

## **Curated Apps:**

- 1. Touch and tracing based to learn letters
- 2. Sound based Kids needs to identify the letters or words spoken by the computer
- 3. Fill in the blanks, Crossword Puzzle words
- 4. Form words seeing the pictures
- 5. Learn Tamil keyboard layout and use it to type the words

## **Virtual Learning**

At the time of Covid 19 Pandemic, as per the State's ordinances of Social Distancing, and in accordance with all local school districts, Tamil school's in-person classes were suspended for two weeks in the month of March. The school board then had a rapid plan to continue the remaining instructions of the academic year in virtual mode and worked diligently during that time in accomplishing it. The remaining classes were conducted virtually through

Google Meet and the school successfully completed the 19-20 Tamil School Year. The transition to virtual mode by teachers and students were phenomenal and smooth with the help of our dedicated technical team. Test revisions, Final tests, Handing over of report cards & certificates, Parent-Teacher meetings, End of school year volunteer meetings were all conducted via online. The school's efforts and coordination in introducing G-Suite in the previous years had already laid a strong foundation which greatly contributed in successfully shifting to the online model of running the school and winding down the year's activities.

## **Teachers Training & Staff Enrichment**

During the summer vacation, in the month of July and August, the Director, teachers and the syllabus review committee reviewed the ATA books and PTS books thoroughly to finalize syllabus for each level. The committee also prepared weekly lesson plans and spread them over the calendar year with 5 Units of 6 weeks each.

Throughout this academic year, teachers and volunteers actively participated in PTS meetings and training.

PTS has been ensuring ongoing collaboration between parents and the school through the 6<sup>th</sup> week mandatory Parent Participation and Teachers Conference. This provided the bridge between parent, teacher and student. Parents have the opportunity to review their child's progress and clarify any open questions.

## **Updates from STF & its activities**

Competitive events are an integral part of the Plano Tamil School program. The parent non-profit organization – Sastha Tamil Foundation – is a strong support for motivating and conducting these events at the school level and outside of the DFW and Texas State level. One of the main goals is to bring out each student's potential. Also, STF treats every participant as a winner to encourage him or her, so that next time they can perform better and improve their skills. To this end, participation certificates and medals are given to all students participating.

#### Communication

## **Tamil Library**

The Plano Tamil School Library is one of the attractions for the students and their parents. In the academic year 2019-2020, few changes were introduced in order to accommodate the student growth and demand since 2010.

Since the school operates in a new location, the Library was operated in one location, the Students from Level 6 – Level 8 conveniently checked out books after their class time and rest of the levels were able to check out either before or after their class time More than 180 **new books were added** as part of this academic year due to the student growth.

This academic year, we had a substantial growth in registration with over **240 registered library members**.

Initially we started this Tamil Library with only 40 books, now we have around **1700+ books**. This collection includes Children's story books, Bilingual books, Novels etc. Our children's books collection has many different varieties. We have books that are suitable for children of all ages, especially the younger children who are just starting to read. We also maintain around 250+ storybooks and magazines for the adults.

## **Reading Log Program**

As part of this reading log program, Library books were given to each class based on the level. These books were distributed and exchanged every week to the students with the help of Room Volunteers or Teachers.

Around **350 level-wise books** were distributed for this Reading log program.

During every 6th week presentation, one student from each class was selected for the reading log winner and awarded during the presentation. This year we have given pencils, highlighters, bookmarks as a gift to those winners. Around **56 winners** are recognized in this academic year.

The students were awarded with free Ice-cream coupons on their effort of reading with the minimum of 30 mins each week for 6 weeks. This enticed and encouraged the students to read more.

One grand prize winner was recognized in each level for the whole academic year.
